





WELCOME TO THE 2014 SEASON!



he 2014 concert season will "step off" with its 10th annual Sousa Season Opener, paying homage to the "March King" by recreating a 1914 national tour concert program. Also receiving tribute this year is the "Waltz King" Johann Strauss Jr., who will be honored with an orchestra concert modeled on the annual Vienna Philharmonic New Year's concert. Other season highlights include a Time Capsule program that will take listeners back to the year 1944, a nod to William Shakespeare in honor of his 450th birthday, and the annual Young People's Concert titled "Schoolhouse Rock (and all that jazz)." There are several unique concert experiences this season, including a Library of Congress program curated by British composer and conductor Oliver Knussen, and appearances by two guest conductors: Giancarlo Guerrero, Music Director of the Nashville Symphony, and James Ross, Director of Orchestras at the University of Maryland.

The 2014 Showcase Series also marks the final performance season for Director Col. Michael J. Colburn, who will retire in a Change of Command Concert in July.
